

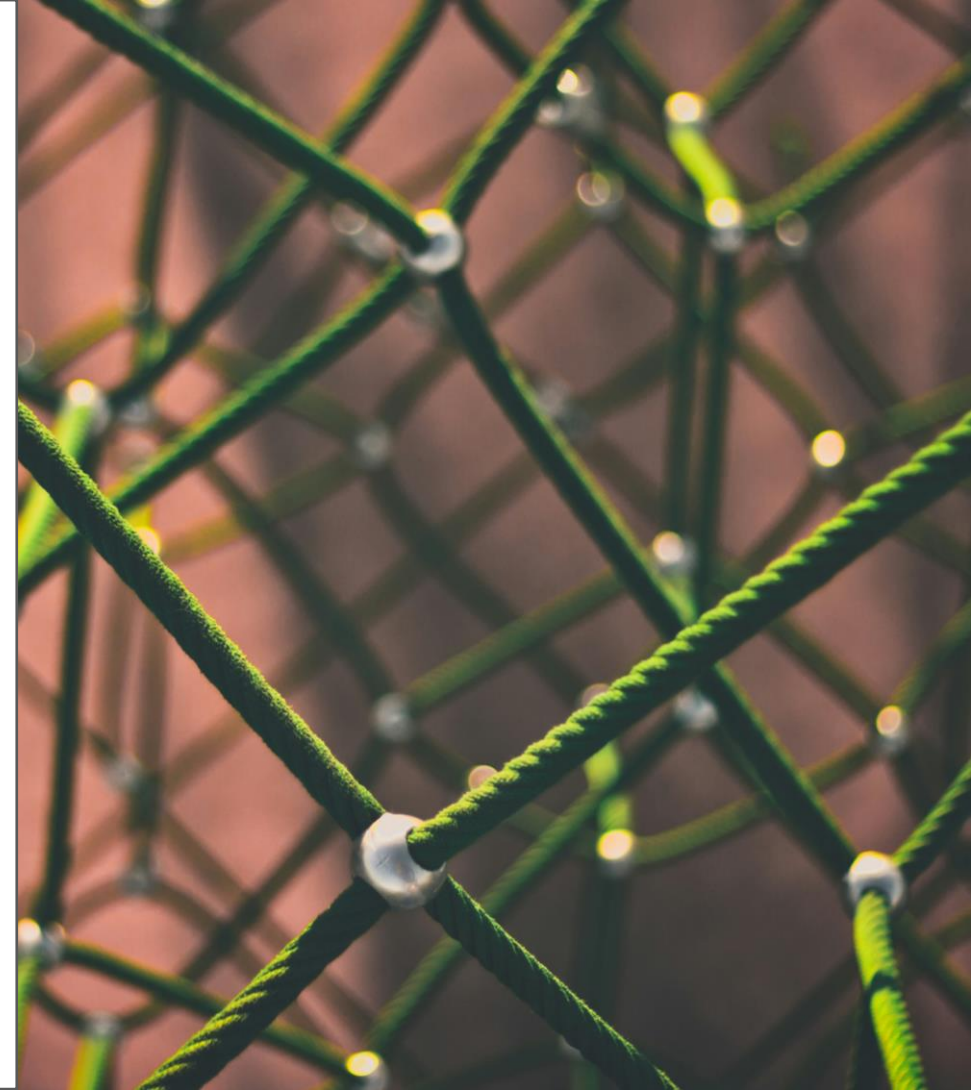

# KEY FINDINGS

**1** Voters broadly are skeptical and concerned about the repercussions of AI.

**2** There is strong bipartisan support for more government regulation of AI.

**4** For employers, proactive efforts to familiarize and educate workers about AI and the opportunities presented by it are essential.

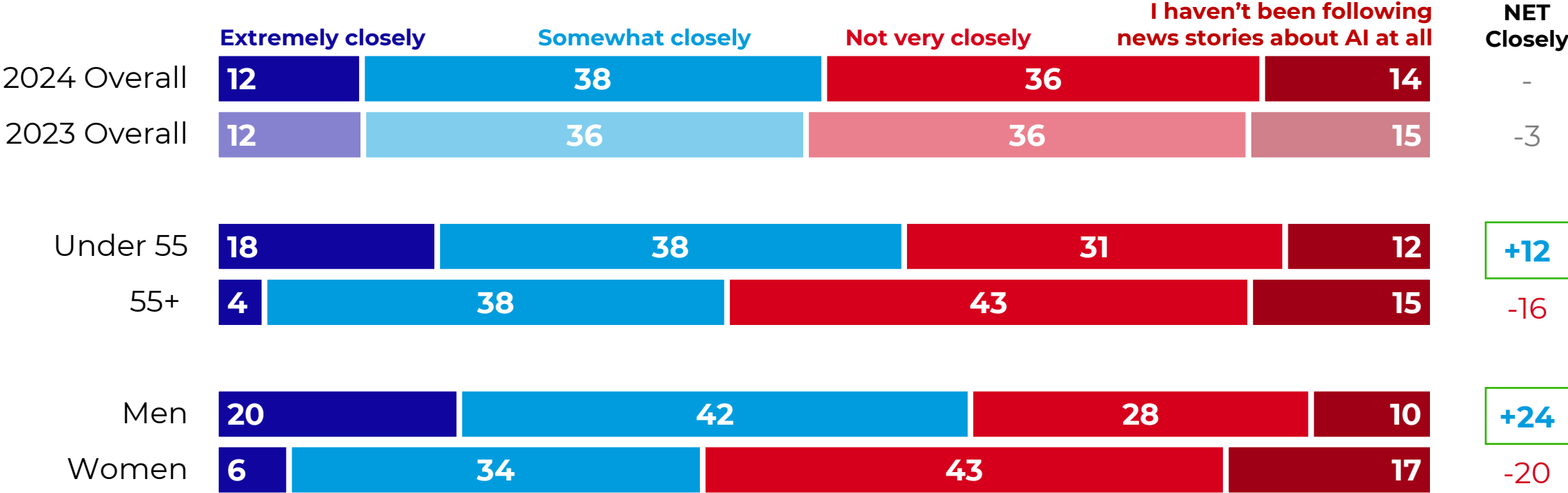

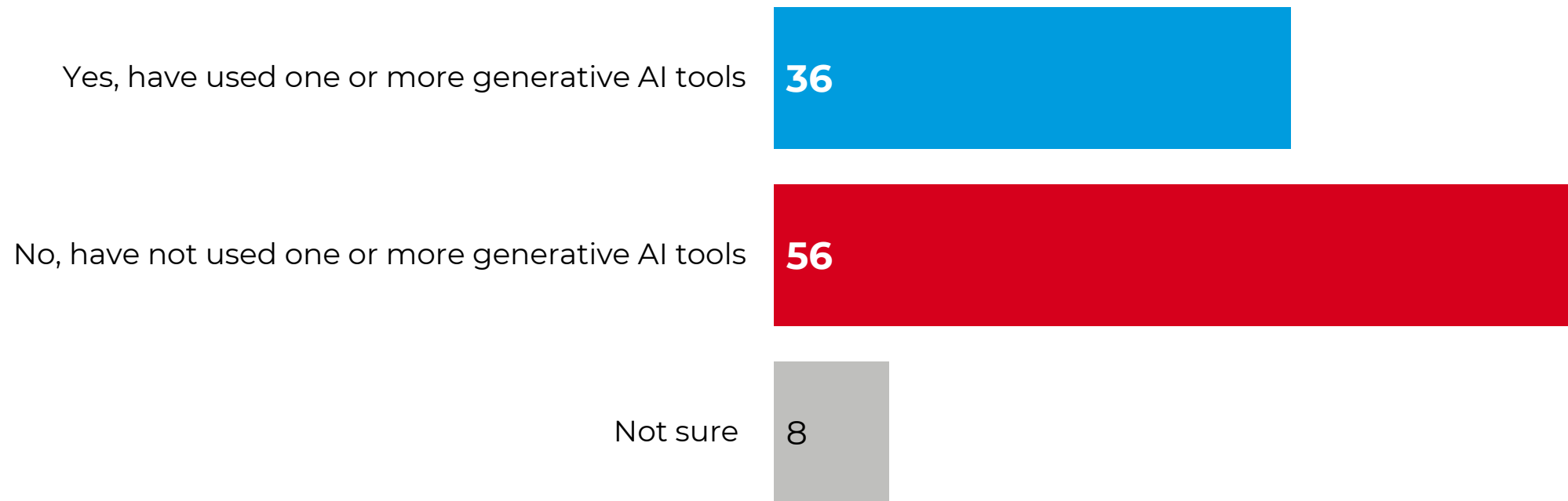

How closely have you been following news stories about artificial intelligence (AI) technology?



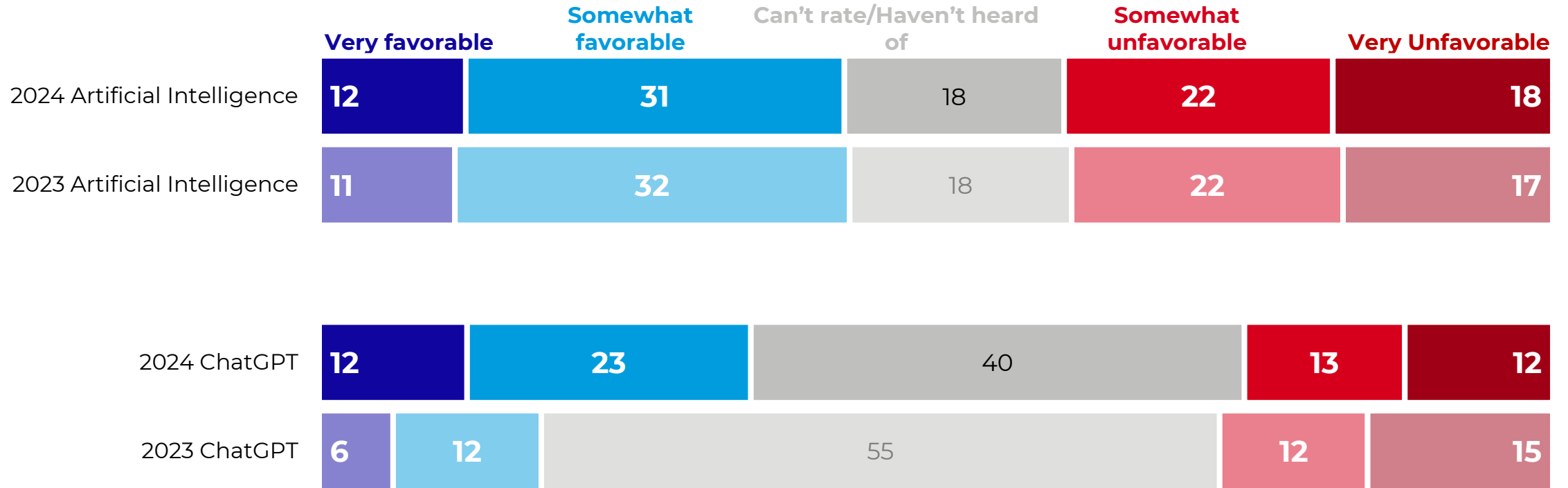
# ONE-THIRD OF VOTERS HAVE USED GENERATIVE AI TOOLS

Have you previously used one or more generative AI tools, for example: ChatGPT, Microsoft Copilot, Google Gemini, or DALL-E?



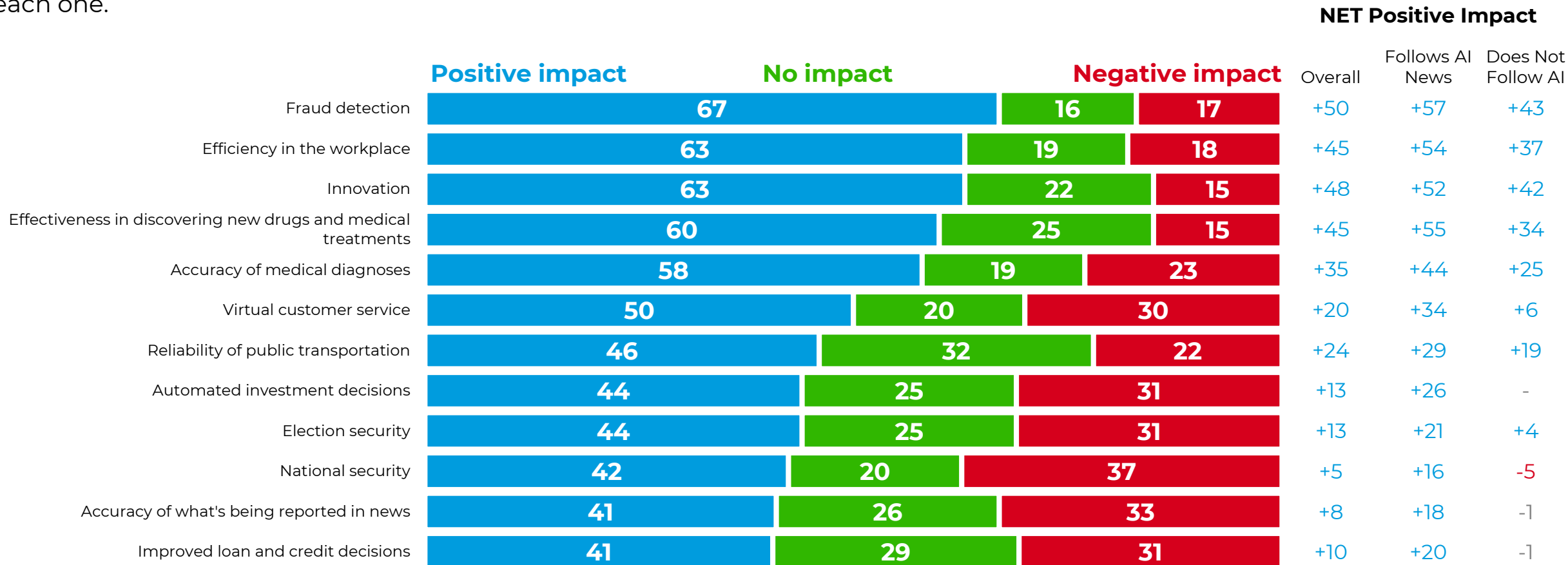

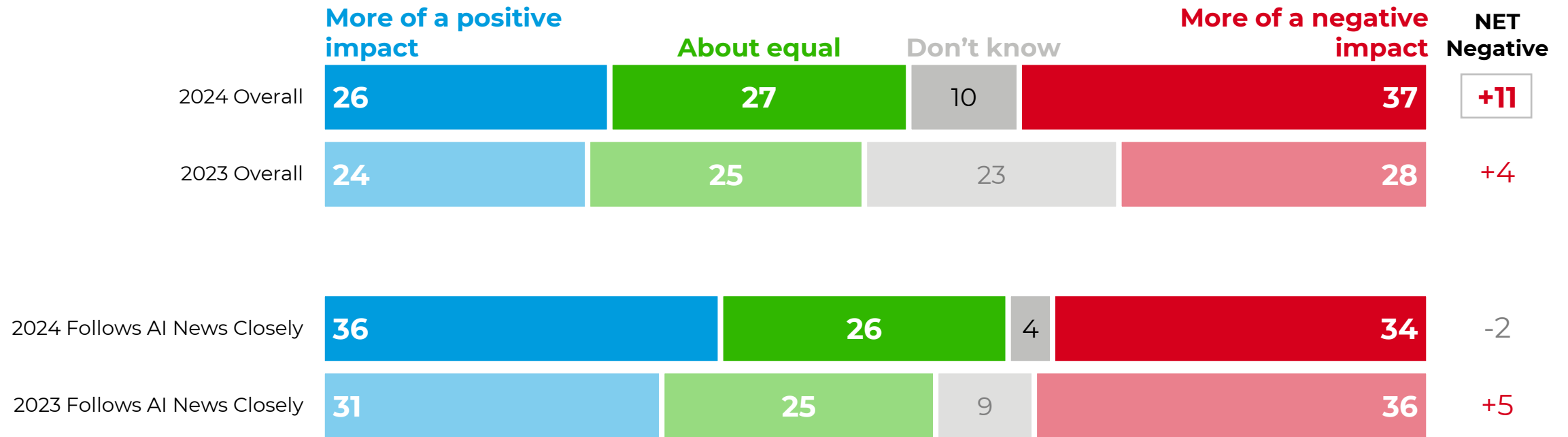

# THE ELECTORATE IS GROWING MORE WORRIED ABOUT THE RISKS OF AI

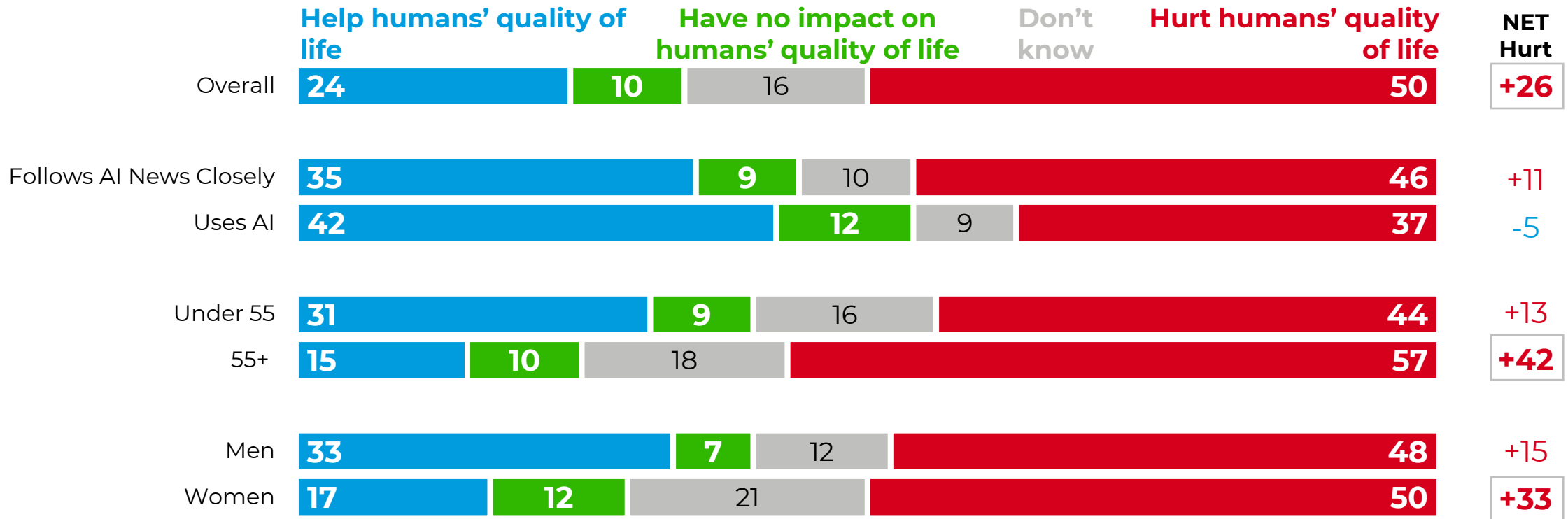
In your opinion, do you think that advancements in AI technology will have more of a positive impact on society or more of a negative impact on society?

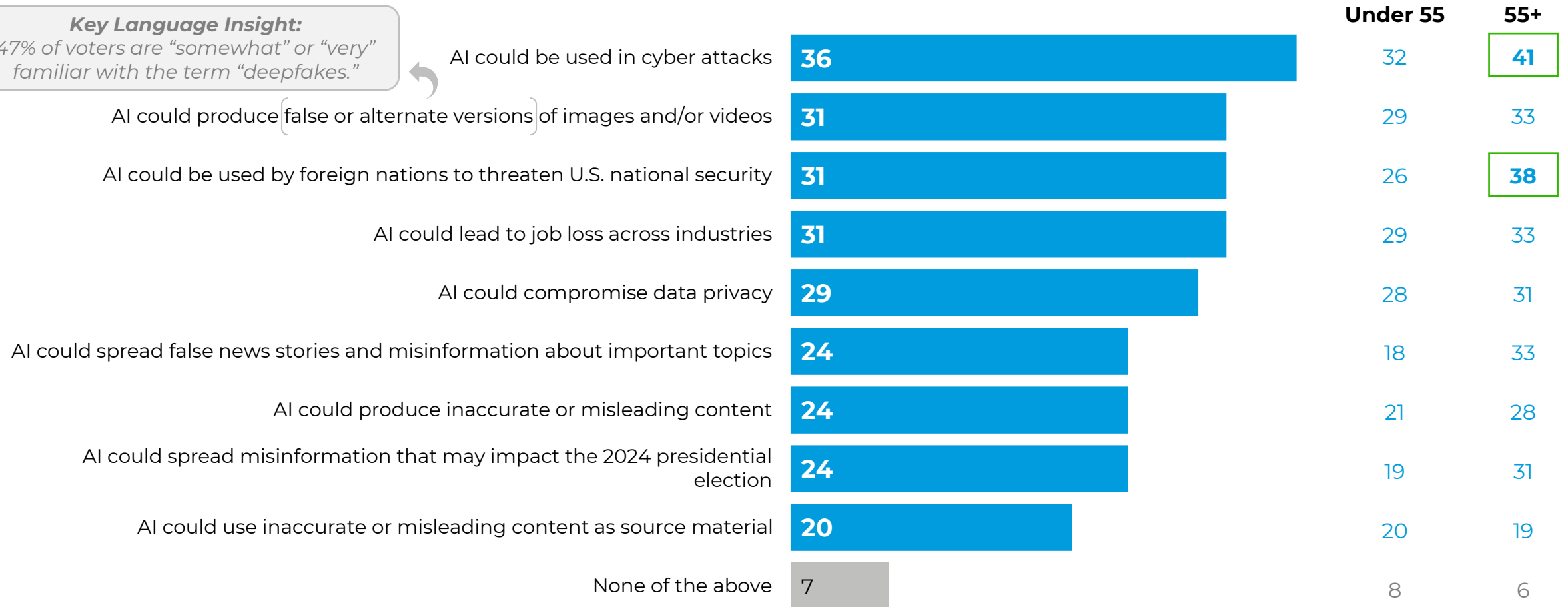
Do you think having machines with the ability to mimic human language will help or hurt human beings' quality of life?

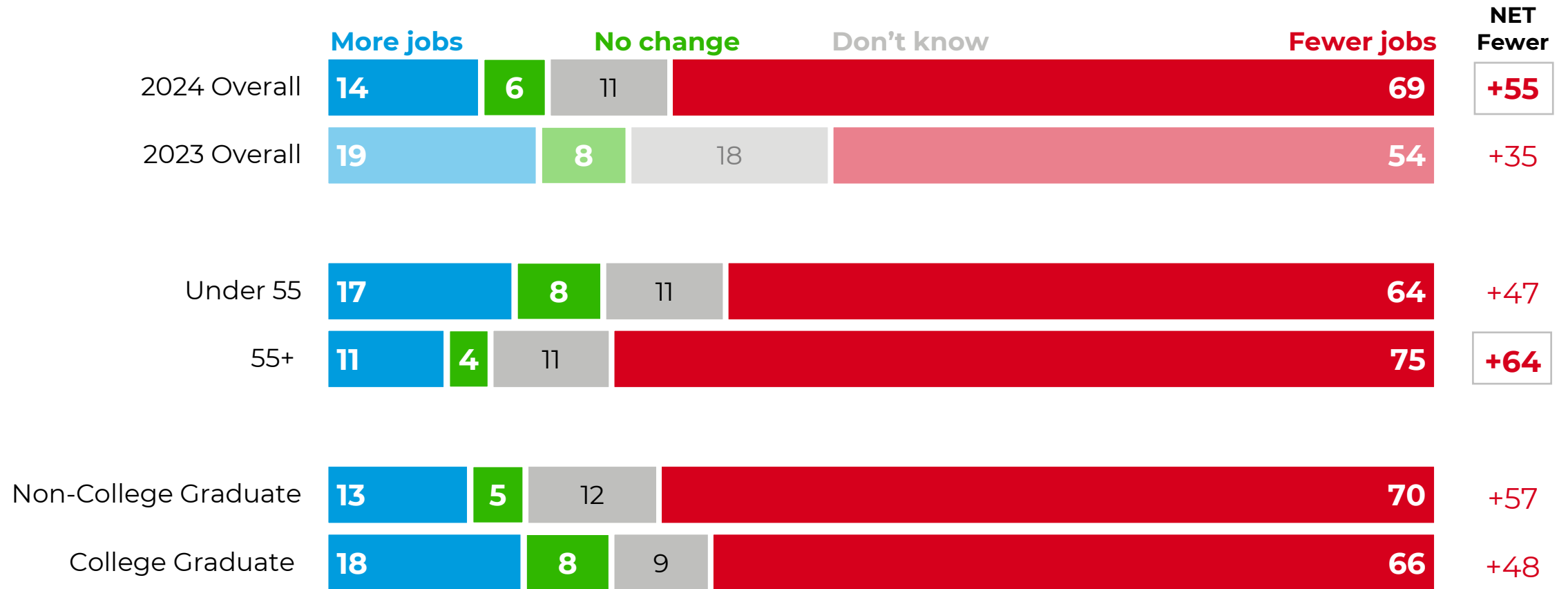

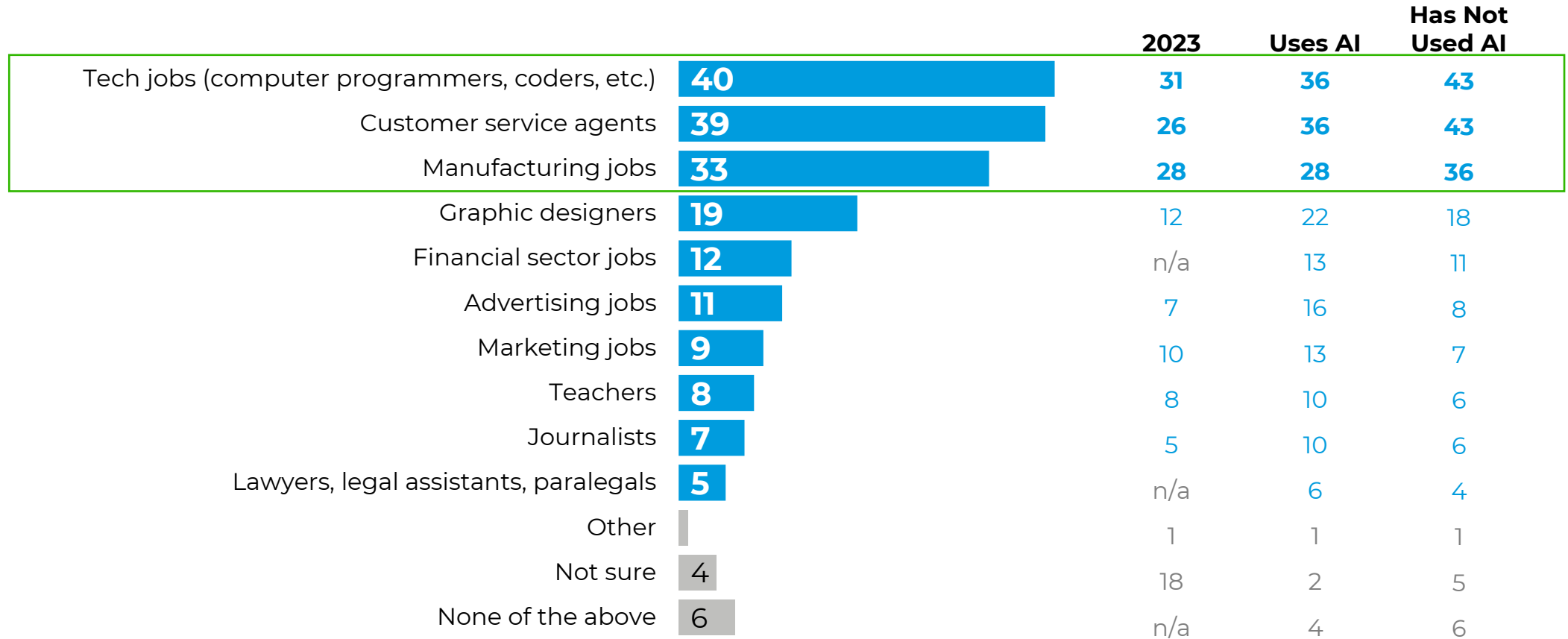
# CONCERNS OVER AI'S THREATS TO THE WORKFORCE ARE GROWING

AI could lead to humans being replaced by AI in the workplace. Please indicate the TWO types of jobs you believe are most likely to replace humans with AI.

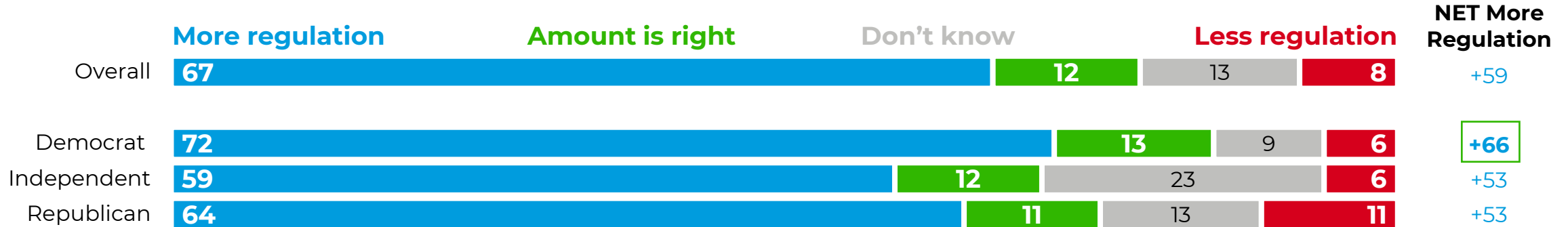

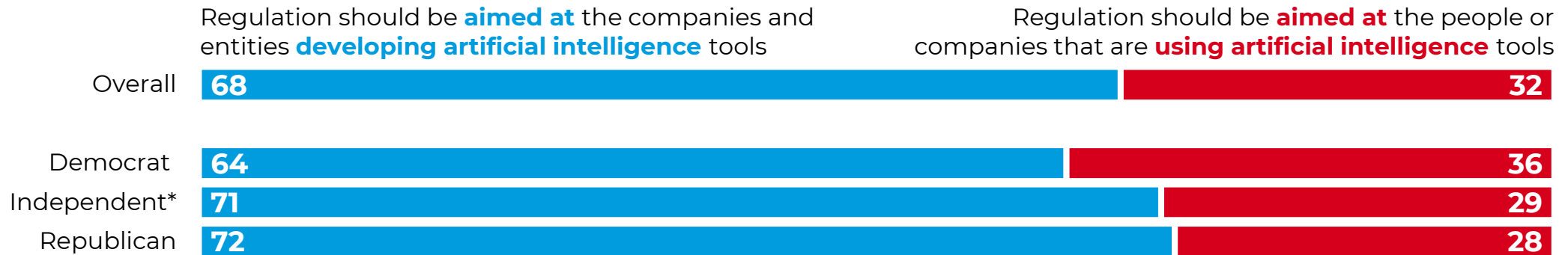

Do you think there should be more or less government regulation of artificial intelligence?



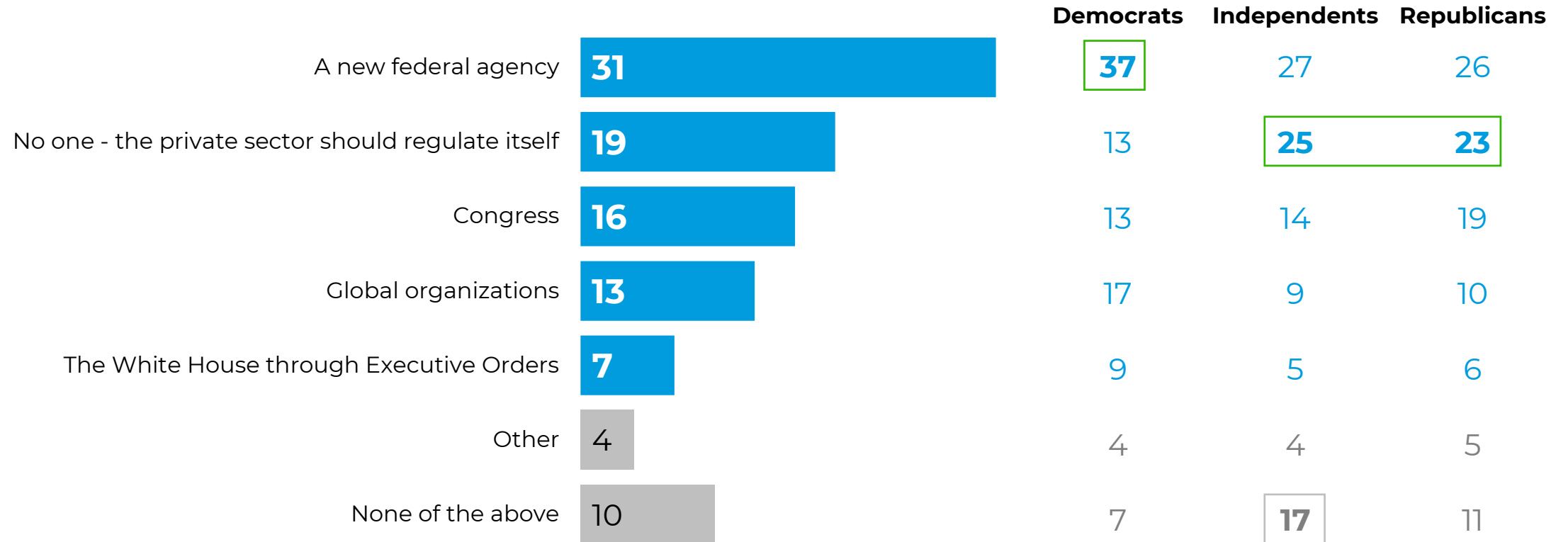

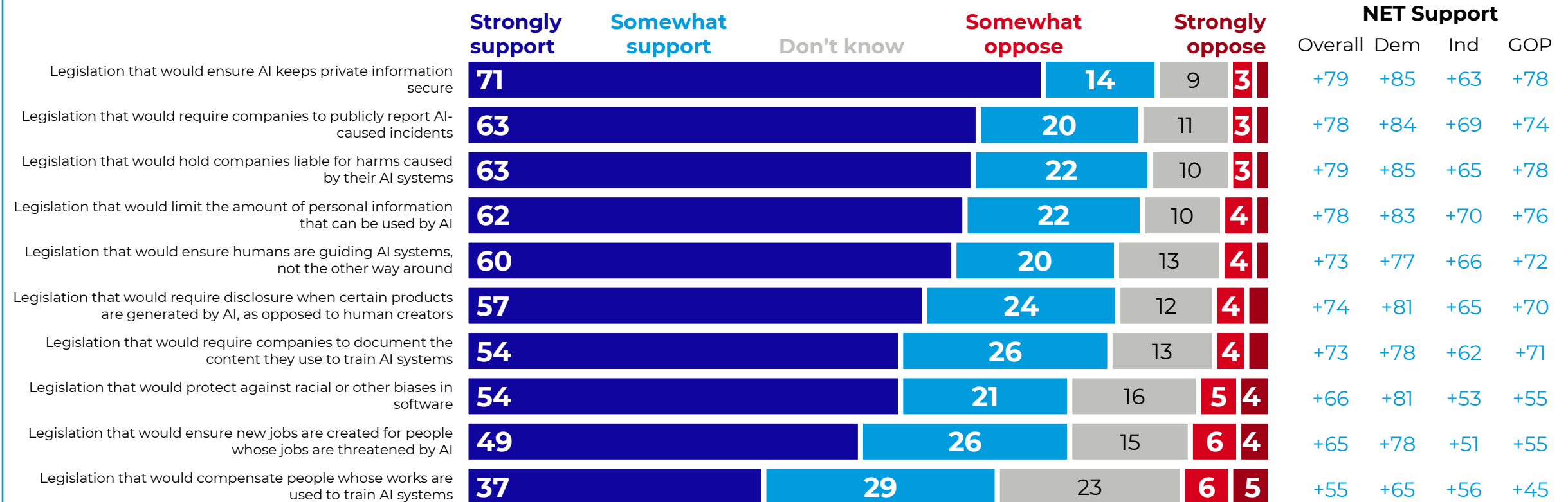

If you had to say, who should be in charge of regulating artificial intelligence?



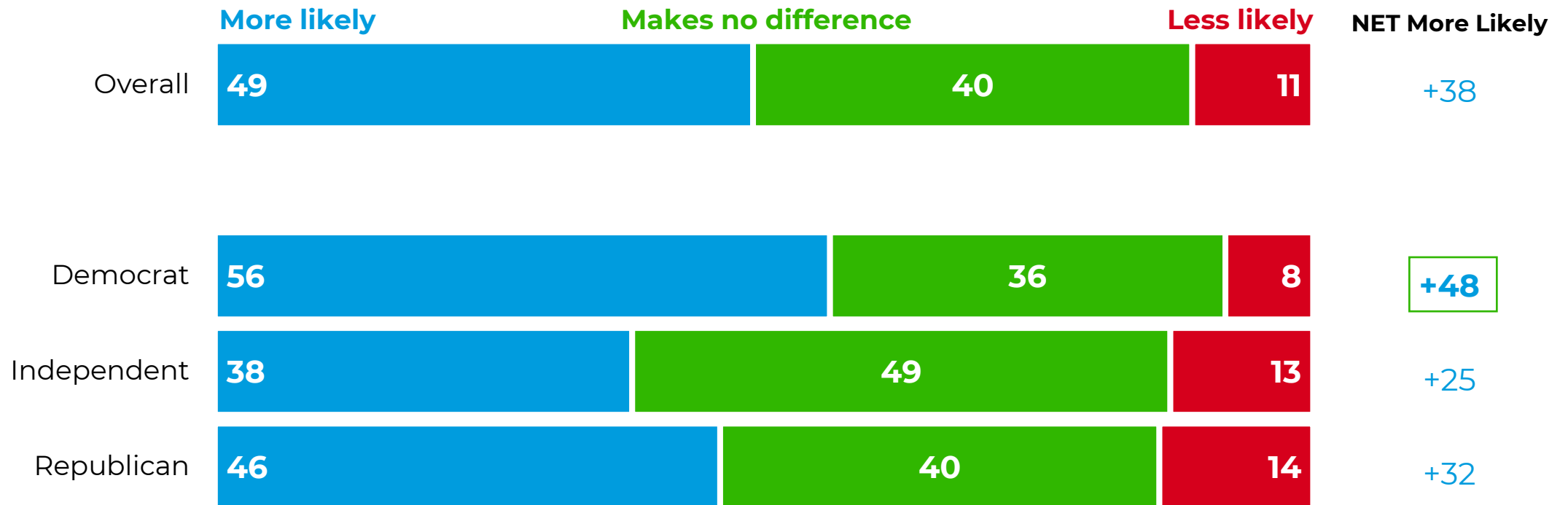

Would you be more or less likely to support a candidate for office if they support increasing regulation on artificial intelligence (AI) technology, or would it make no difference?

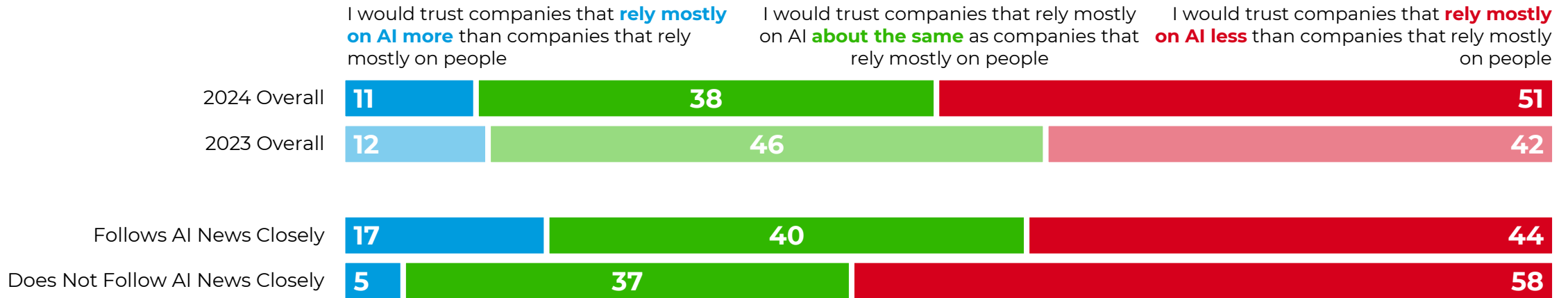

Would you trust a company that relies mostly on AI?

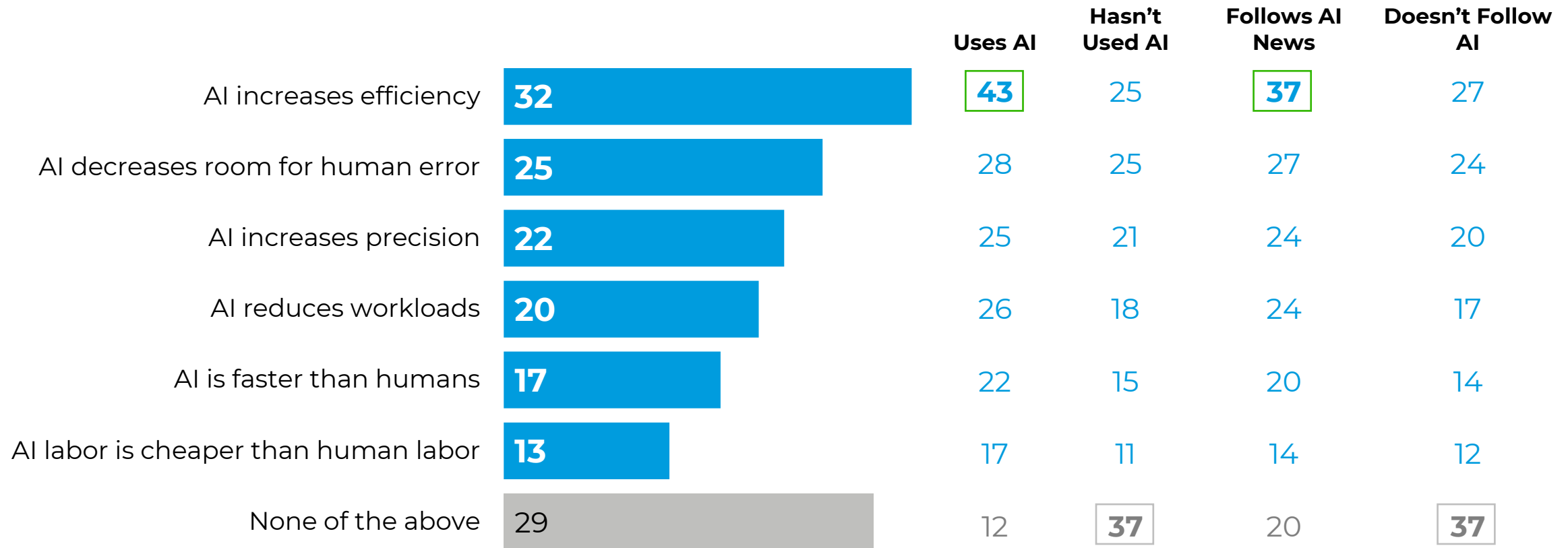


Is it okay for companies to replace people with AI?

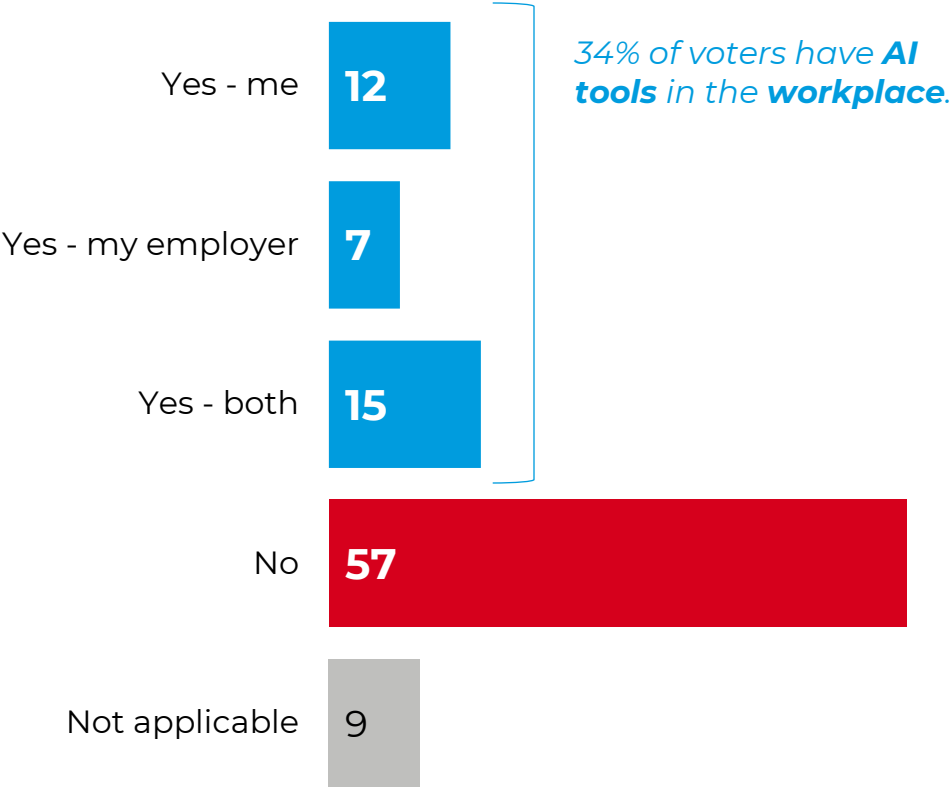

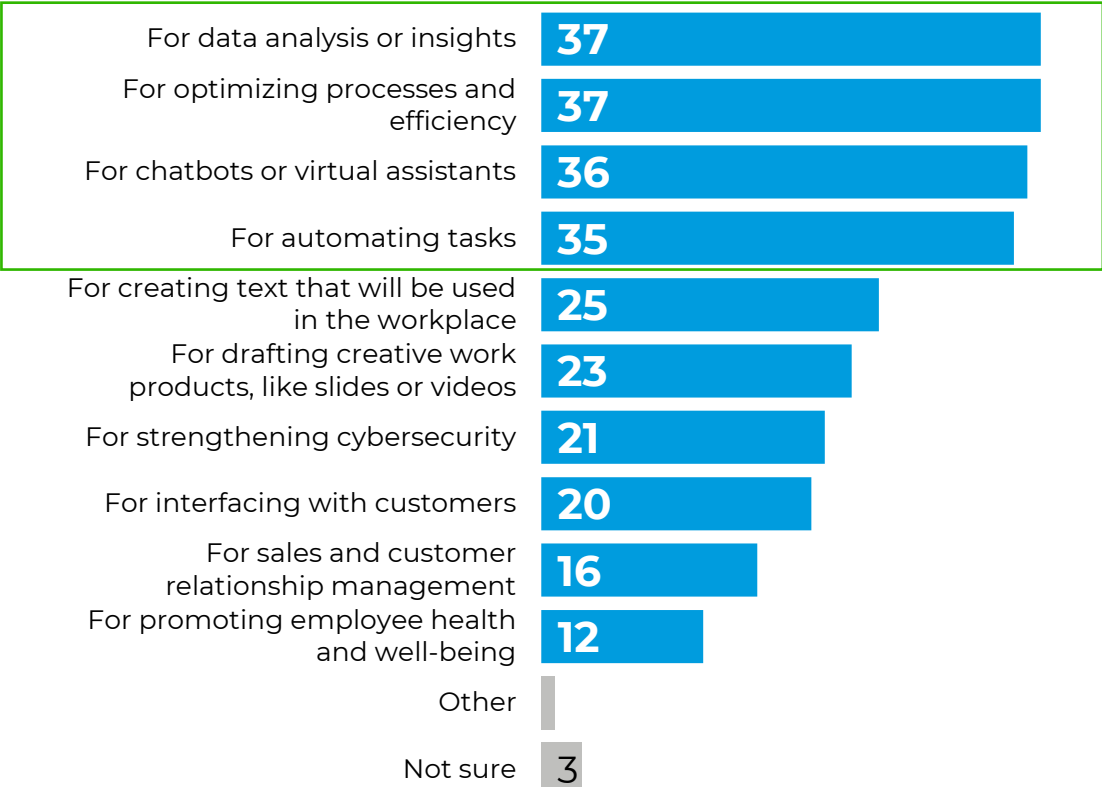


# EMPLOYEES ALREADY USING AI IN THE WORKPLACE ARE MOSTLY DOING SO TO INCREASE EFFICIENCY

**[IF EMPLOYED]** Thinking about your own personal experience, do you or your employer use AI tools in the workplace?

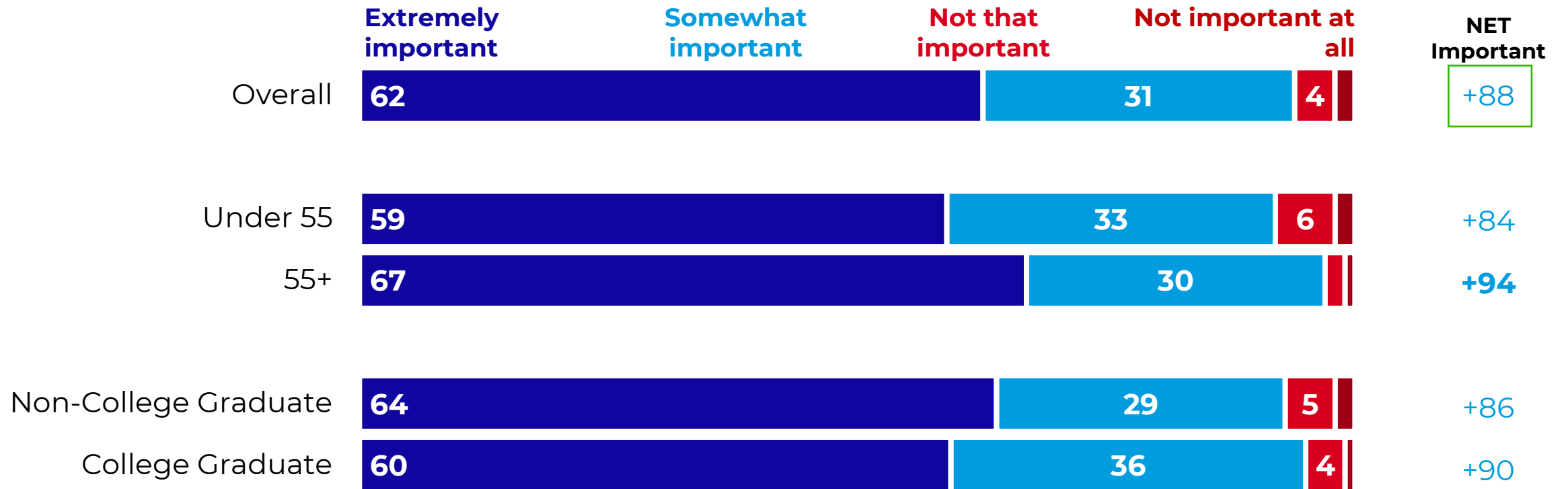


**[IF USE AI IN WORKPLACE]** In what ways do you or your employer use AI in the workplace?



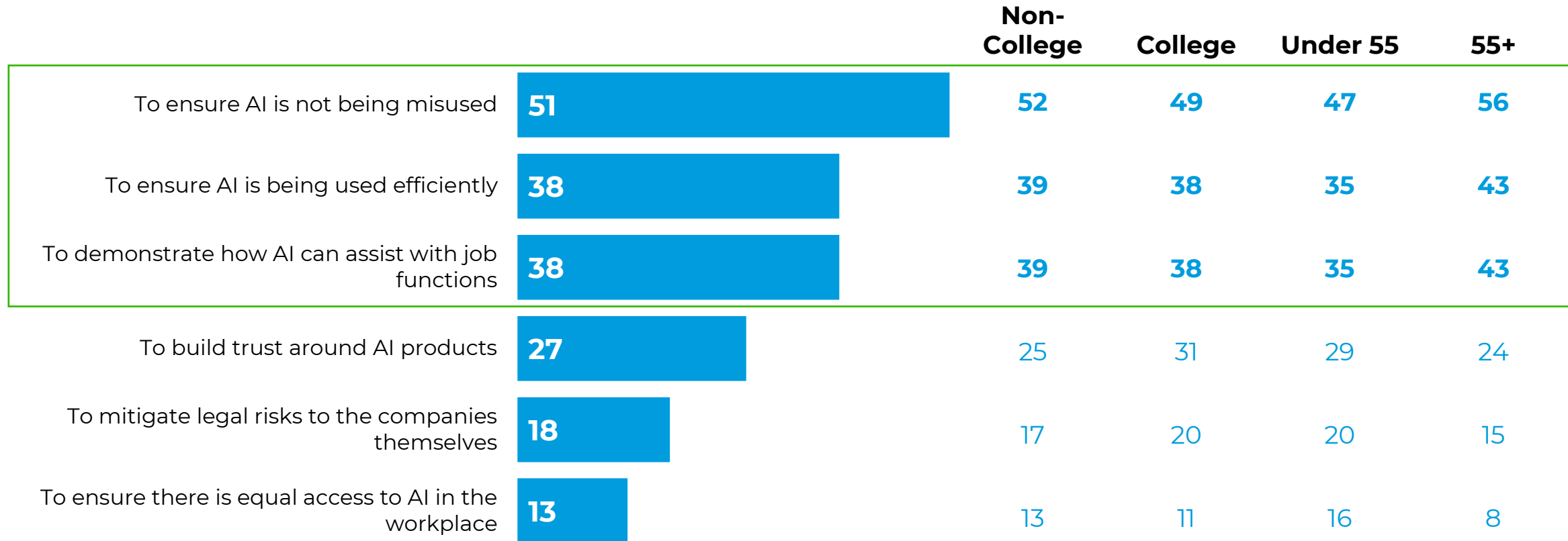
